Tutoring sessions are held on Saturdays from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm in one-hour sessions taking place at 12:00 noon, 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm for children from Pre-K3 through high school. We do our best to provide 1:1 tutoring utilizing Zoom breakout rooms. Most of the subjects we tutor are reading and math. However, on occasion a student may need help with a specific project.
